I want to express on behalf of myself and everyone at Longshore our deep regret and sadness over a tragic loss of life at one of our well sites on Friday, November 16, 2018. Our hearts go out to the family members and loved ones of the deceased. We will be offering support in whatever way we can. Next-of-kin have been notified. The name of the deceased will not be released before consent has been received.

What we know is that at approximately 6:15PM MDT on Friday, November 16<sup>th</sup> a contractor, working at Longshore's 16-15-77-08W6 well site facility, located approximately 15 kilometers Southwest of Spirit River AB, experienced a medical emergency believed to be unrelated to work operations. Emergency response procedures were immediately implemented and workers on site administered first aid and contacted emergency services. An ambulance transported the individual to the Grande Prairie Hospital. Tragically, the contractor did not survive. RCMP have visited the site and other appropriate regulatory authorities have been contacted.

The cause of death is not yet known but suspected to be of natural causes. The wellsite location is not a risk to the public, the environment or Longshore workers.

Once again, our deepest condolences to the family, friends and coworkers of the deceased.
